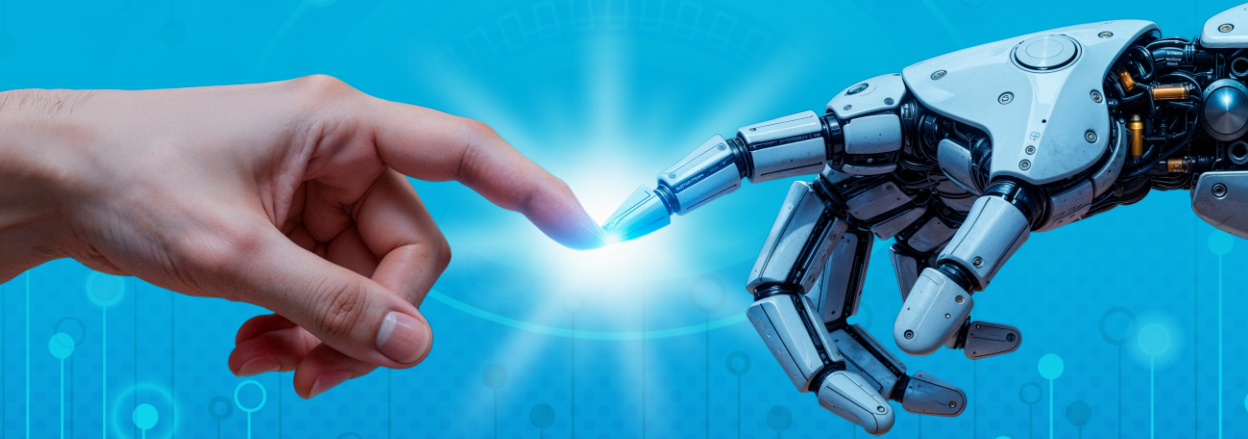

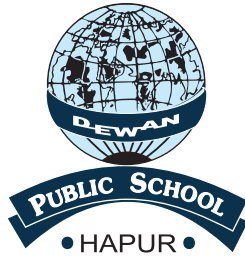

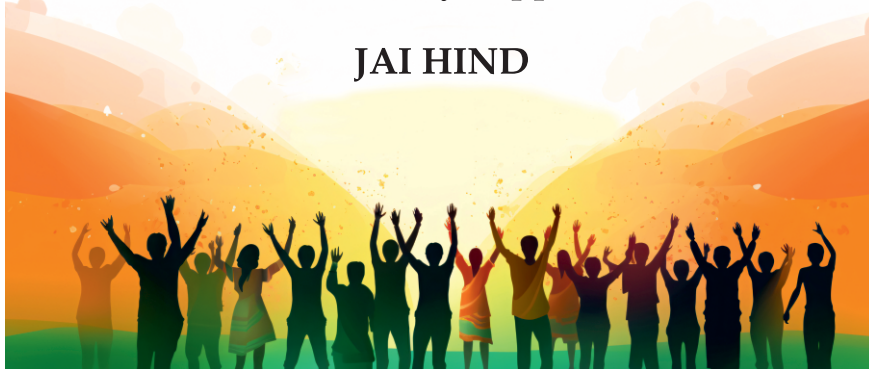

SCHOOL RULES

1. Students must be punctual. They should arrive at the school 5 minutes before the first bell. Once the gate is closed, entry will not be permitted.
2. School uniform in exact colour and pattern is compulsory on all school days, PTM's and at all school functions.
3. Students should come to school clean and tidy with trim hair-do. Nails must be clipped short. Use of mehendi, hair colour, hair gel, make-up, nail polish is not permitted. Ear studs for boys, bracelets and tattoos are strictly prohibited.
4. Students are not allowed to leave the school nor receive visitors during the school hours.
5. Students should not unnecessarily leave their class at the end of a period. While going to the playground, lab, library etc. they should move silently and in an orderly manner.
6. Students must take care of their belongings. Articles like expensive watches, costly pens, jewellery and glares / goggles are strictly prohibited. School will not be responsible for goods lost.
7. Polythene bags are banned in school. Students should make use of the litter bins and take special care to keep the campus clean.
8. Exploding crackers and splashing colours in and around the school premises are strictly banned.
9. Students suffering from infectious/contagious diseases shall, under no circumstances, be permitted to attend school until full recovery.
10. Birthday celebrations, exchange of gifts, and distribution of sweets are strictly prohibited.
11. No student is permitted to leave the classroom without obtaining the official class outpass.
12. Students requiring a visit to the infirmary must ensure that the proforma (available on page 38) is duly completed and signed by the concerned teacher before proceeding.





DISCIPLINARY POLICY & CONDUCT REGULATIONS (Session 2026–27)

At Dewan Public School, discipline is the foundation of character, respect and excellence. Every student is expected to uphold the dignity of the school through responsible behaviour, regular attendance, disciplined conduct and respect for teachers, peers and school property.

GENERAL CONDUCT RULES

Students must:

- Maintain exemplary behaviour inside and outside the school.
- Show respect towards teachers, staff, fellow students, and visitors.
- Be punctual, regular and well-groomed in proper school uniform.
- Observe classroom discipline and maintain silence in corridors.
- Carry identity card and school diary daily.
- Complete assignments, homework and projects sincerely.
- Protect school property and environment.
- Refrain from use of abusive language, bullying, misbehaviour or misconduct.
- Avoid bringing prohibited items: mobile phones, gadgets, sharp objects, objectionable material or valuables.
- Follow all school safety, cyber safety, transportation and campus conduct norms.

STRICTLY PROHIBITED ACTS

Any student found involved in the following shall face strict disciplinary action:

- Disrespect, misbehaviour or disobedience towards teachers/staff.
- Bullying, ragging, violence, threats or physical/mental harassment.
- Damaging school property, defacing walls or furniture.
- Cheating in exams, forgery of signatures, tampering records.
- Truancy, bunking classes, leaving campus without permission.
- Use / possession of mobile phones or gadgets in school.
- Use/possession of tobacco, alcohol, drugs or any harmful substance.
- Cyber bullying, spreading false information, sharing inappropriate content.
- Any conduct bringing disgrace to the school.



DISCIPLINARY ACTION SYSTEM

Step-1: YELLOW CARD (Warning Stage)

Issued for:

- First-time misconduct
- Repeated minor indiscipline
- Breach of classroom rules

Action Taken

- Written Warning + Yellow Card issued
- Parents informed
- Behaviour Counseling Session may be conducted
- Record maintained

Step-2: RED CARD (Serious Misconduct)

Issued for:

- Repeated offence after 3 Yellow Card
- Major violation of school rules
- Misconduct affecting school discipline

Action Taken

- Suspension for a specified period
- Parent meeting mandatory
- Undertaking to be signed by student & parents
- Record maintained

Step-3: TERMINATION POLICY

If

- A student receives **two Red Cards**
OR
- Commits an extremely serious offence

Action Taken

- Termination from school
- Transfer Certificate may be issued
- Decision of the School Management shall be final

SPECIAL NOTE

The School Management reserves the right to:

- Modify/amend any disciplinary guidelines when required
- Suspend/expel any student immediately in case of serious moral, safety, criminal, or discipline-related offence
- Take legal action wherever applicable

Discipline at Dewan Public School is meant not to punish but to correct, guide and help students grow as responsible human beings.

IMPORTANT : Breach of School rules/norms or misconduct will be seriously viewed and recorded. Cases of recurrence of such acts or indiscipline of serious nature will lead to suspension. In spite of it, if a student does not take to correction and indulges in repeated indiscipline, he/she is liable to be dismissed from the school.

LANGUAGE

The medium of instruction being English, it is mandatory for every one to communicate in English in the school premises. Compliance to this rule will not only provide an opportunity for practice but also enhance language efficiency.

ATTENDANCE

The School expects every student to attend the classes regularly with minimum 75% of attendance. In case of shortage of attendance, a student will not be eligible for promotion/any academic award. It is also compulsory to remain present on the last working day before vacation/break as well as on the reopening day.

1. No student shall be absent from the school without obtaining prior sanction of leave. Parents should send the leave application to the class teacher well in advance.
2. If a student fails to come to school on a particular day due to sudden illness or an urgent and unforeseen circumstance, parent should inform the class teacher that day itself. In such cases, the leave application should be sent the next day.
3. If the absence is due to illness, a Medical Fitness Certificate from the doctor should be enclosed along with the leave application.
4. If a student absents from school without intimation/ permission for more than 10 days, his/her name will be struck off the rolls.



RULES FOR COMMUTING

I-V Students to commute by school bus / as arranged by parents.

VI-XII By school bus / as arranged by parents / cycles (if commuting from short distance).

Note : While engaging a private vehicle, e-rickshaw, autorickshaw, van, matador etc, parents may please ensure that it is road worthy, not run on a gas kit and that the number of children are not beyond capacity, these being rather risky. Parents should also ensure that the driver is competent, reliable, having valid licence and observes traffic rules as well as speed limit. It is further advised to have the police verification of the driver done. Parents/relatives dropping/collecting students by two wheelers must wear crash helmet.

IMPORTANT

1. Boys will have a trim hairdo. Turban, if worn, will be light blue.
2. No elaborate hairdo is allowed for girls. Those with long hair should plait it with light blue ribbons/hair bands/clips.
3. Fancy wears like wrist bands, bracelets, studs, rings, nose pins, fancy earrings are not allowed.
4. School Uniform is compulsory on all school days, including tests, examinations, functions, PTM's and tours.
5. School bag should be light and not too heavy. Parents should ensure that the student brings books and notebooks as per the day's time table only.



FACILITIES, SERVICES & ACTIVITIES

LIBRARY

The School Library is well stocked including a special reference section. Fresh titles are added, on a regular basis. The library subscribes to a wide range of magazines, journals and dailies. Students are advised to develop habit of reading and make the best use of the library.



LABS

The school has developed state-of-the-art, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Composite Labs along with department rooms for Painting, Music & Dance. During practicals in Chemistry, it is compulsory to wear White Aprons and follow safety norms.



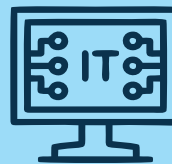
DIGI CLASSROOMS

To enhance teaching learning process all the classrooms have been converted into digi-classrooms. This enables immediate and permanent impact on the learners, making learning convenient, easy and interesting.



IT CENTRE

The school IT Centre has three labs with PCs under Local Area Network (LAN). The school expects every student to be computer literate. Coding, Machine Learning and Artificial Intelligence are incorporated in the school curriculum to help, prepare the students for the challenges and opportunities of the digital world.



CLINIC

The school has a clinic which attends to the students for any minor injury/sickness. The services of a qualified nurse and an attendant are available. In addition, school has its own fully equipped ambulance. The Clinic organises health awareness programme from time to time. Parents are requested to submit the Health Card, given in the almanac, duly filled in by a physician / registered medical practitioner to the class teacher.



COUNSELLING CELL

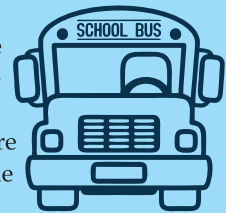
CELEBRATIONS/FESTIVALS
